NM State Football versus Fresno State on ESPNU

LAS CRUCES, N.M. – ESPNU announced late Monday afternoon that it will televise the New Mexico State versus Fresno State game on October 24, at Aggie Memorial Stadium. Game time for the contest has been changed to 8:20 p.m. (MST)

The Aggies face the Bulldogs for the 16th time in school history on October 24, as the NM State hosts Fresno State for the ninth time in Las Cruces. The Bulldogs hold a 15-0 series lead over the Aggies.

The series dates back to the 1972 season when the Bulldogs traveled to Las Cruces. Fresno State won that game 49-17. The Aggies would get a chance at revenge two years later as the Bulldogs again made their way to the Mesilla Valley, but NMSU fell just short 9-7. The two schools became conference foes in 1984 as both were members of the Pacific Coast Conference and the Big West until 1992 when Fresno State made the jump to the WAC. As conference opponents in the WAC, this will be the fifth meeting.
